Hillsborough Teachers Join with First Book and Community Supporters To Launch Partnership That Will Provide Free Books to Local Students

May 31 Events at Crestwood Elementary School Will Include Student Assemblies, Visits by Leaders of National Groups, and Reading by Award-Winning Children's Author

TAMPA—Leaders of organizations working together to get free books into the hands of Hillsborough County children will gather with students, teachers and staff, and community supporters at Crestwood Elementary School on Thursday, May 31, to present free books to kids there, discuss the new partnership, and join with an award-winning children's author to celebrate reading and literacy.

Every student at the school will receive a new free book that they selected with their teachers. The Hillsborough Classroom Teachers Association is partnering with First Book, a national nonprofit organization that has distributed more than 90 million new, high-quality books free to kids across the country.
