The NEA-Retired Annual Meeting was held June 29-30, 2023, in Orlando. Your Vice President represented you, our Hillsborough Educators Association - Retired members, as well as the NJREA delegation, from which he was elected. The first day dealt mainly with meeting procedures—vacancies on NEA-R positions and how to fill them. At the end of the first day of meetings, a short celebration of the 40th birthday of NEA-Retired was held, with birthday cake and coffee. The second day, voting was held. Three motions dealing with NEA-R passed. In addition, we elected a new NEA-R President, Anita Gibson, to replace our outgoing President, Sarah Borgman (who won the NEA-Retired Distinguished Service Award). The meeting ended on a positive note when FEA-R President, Janice Poirier, announced she will be running next year for reelection to the NEA-Retired Executive Council. At the Annual NEA Representative Assembly held in the following days in Orlando, the NEA Leadership was re-elected for three more years: President Becky Pringle, Vice President Princess Moss, and Secretary/Treasurer Noel Candelaria. Many NBI's Legislative Amendments, Policy Statements, Resolutions, Bylaw Amendments, and Standing Rules Amendments were discussed and debated over four full days at the Convention Center. President Joe Biden and Kamala Harris were overwhelmingly endorsed for re-election! It was a great and long Convention, as retirees, including myself, spent 10 days and 9 nights in Orlando.
