VBM for School Board! The August primary elections are when we vote for school board members, so be sure to renew your vote-by-mail application this month. Check your status at your county's Supervisor of Elections website since all VBMs expired in January 2023 by state law. See future newsletters for candidates endorsed by HCTA and the Central Labor Council.

The School Board voted 5-2 on April 29 to keep two challenged books in high school libraries. District procedures first called for reviews by a school committee and if appealed, by a district committee of curriculum areas and student social services. 75% of almost 30 public comments supported district staff to keep the books. Board members explained their votes based on detailed transcripts, book reviews, legal advice on state laws, their own research, and on their professional responsibilities.
